## Using the PicoScope & Launchpad CprE 288 - Lab 7

Note: Use caution when connecting and disconnecting probes and wires. Ask a TA if you need assistance.

## Directions

1. Plug the probe into the bottom left plug and the USB cable into the top USB port.

- 2. Ensure the Launchpad and cyBot are OFF for this portion:
  - a. Connect the ground alligator clip to the Launchpad's ground pin

- b. Disconnect the Ping sensor from Ping 1.
- c. Connect the probe to the bottom of the pin.
- d. Reconnect the Ping sensor: note the probe is connected to the white wire's pin.

- 3. Connect the USB to the computer.
- 4. Find the PicoScope program through the Start menu.

## 5. Change these settings:

- a. Trigger = Repeat
- b. Grid = 5 ms/div
- c. Amplitude = 1 V

6. Turn on the Launchpad.

- 7. The view should look similar to figure x.
- 8. Turn off the Launchpad before disconnecting the probe.
